

WARM HOME DISCOUNT: UP TO £120 OFF YOUR ELECTRICITY BILL!!!

Energy Suppliers are offering up to £120 rebate on electricity bills as part of a Government funded scheme.

If you are on Pension Credit you may get a discount. Your supplier should contact you before the end of 2011

If you are on any of the following you may also be eligible:

- A means tested benefit
- Have an illness and/or disability
- Child Tax Credit that includes a Disability or Severe Disability Premium.
- Have a child under 5 living with them (on the 1st April 2011)
- Disability Living Allowance.
- On a low income of less than £16,190
- Spend 10% or more on adequate heating (21 degree living room, 18 degree elsewhere)

The rules are different for each energy supplier. Check with your energy supplier to see if you qualify:
